



SESSIONAL WORKER

Job Description

Job Summary

The post-holder will be responsible for the delivery of a range of services to young carers in Fife on a sessional basis, primarily focussing on the co-facilitation of group-work activities and occasional one to one emotional support as required.

Reporting to Support Worker/Manager the post-holder will be part of a small team of staff and volunteers, all of whom will be expected to contribute to the design and delivery of services to young carers and development of the organisation.

Responsible to

The local Support Worker or Manager, will provide regular support and supervision on an individual basis.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the setting up and delivery of a range of supportive activities (eg fortnightly support groups, issue based groups, outings, weekend activities, holidays etc)
- Work face to face with young carers in both group and one to one settings
- Listen, befriend, enable and support young carers and pass on any relevant concerns to the Support Worker.
- Assist in involving young carers in all aspects of the shaping and development of Fife Young Carers services and evaluation of its work.
- Maintain confidentiality over personal information relating to individual users of the service.
- To adhere to Fife Young Carers Policies and Practice in relation to child protection practice.
- Attend and contribute to regular supervision sessions and undertake necessary training as required.
- Work as part of a team to contribute to the smooth and effective running of Fife Young Carers.
- Assist with fund raising as appropriate.
- Undertake other appropriate duties as required

Hours of Work

Variable, evenings, weekends and school holidays as required.

Travel Allowance

The post-holder must be willing to travel throughout Fife and occasionally further. Travel expenses will be paid in accordance with current mileage allowances or Public Transport cost.

Disclosure.

A full disclosure check through the PVG scheme is mandatory.
